## Governmental initiative for safe & orderly migration

Nepali migrant workers employed overseas will be able to renew their work permits in the country where they work. This means they will not have to visit govt offices back home in Nepal for re-entry work permits, the govt's permission to work abroad. The move is expected to provide relief to tens of thousands of workers who had no option but to return to Nepal and visit the Foreign Employment Office in Kathmandu, or one of the provincial offices to obtain re-entry labour permits.
